Dear Parents and Carers,

10<sup>th</sup> January 2022

As we move forward and continue to be faced with our children being at home for various lengths of time due to the current Covid 19 guidelines around testing and self-isolation, we wanted to update you with our current home learning offer. Ensuring your child continues to receive continuity of education whilst at home is of great importance to us as we face the Omicron variant.

A reminder that if there is a positive case within the household (sibling or parent), the recommendation from the local authority public health team is that your child has a PCR test and awaits the results at home, prior to returning to school. We would really appreciate your support with this in order to keep everyone safe.

For children who are at home waiting for test results, the following will be available:

- Learning Log, Reading Eggs, Times table Rock Stars. Reception children will also have access to Rocket Phonics

For children who are self-isolating or at home due to a positive PCR or LFT result, the following will be available and shared on Seesaw. Please contact school if you require any of your child's logins.

- Learning Log, Reading Eggs, Times table Rock Stars. Reception children will also have access to Rocket Phonics
- 4 maths lessons, their current learning
- For English - a reading comprehension lesson, a creative writing session and 2 other sessions linked to their current learning
- One RHE lesson
- One RE lesson – from the current unit
- A wellbeing lesson, with a variety of activities to choose from

Should a class have to close, we will revert to our full home learning offer. This will involve books being sent home and the class teacher recording lessons to be watched at home. Lessons will be uploaded on to Seesaw and your child's class teacher will maintain contact through Seesaw and Teams. In this instance a full curriculum will be taught as before.

In every case, we will consider the needs of your child and your family and endeavour to support you in any way we can. Please contact Mrs Henderson if you have any questions.
