










Make a poster of this person. This can be a real person (like a friend or family member) or a story character.</p> 	<h3>History</h3> <p>How have Fire Stations changed? There were not any fire stations until 1666! This was because of the Great Fire of London! Have a look at how Fire Stations have changed and write about this. How you present this is up to you. A poster? A leaflet? A PowerPoint?</p> 
<h3>Music</h3> <p>Create your own music based around the Great Fire of London! How can you make a sound like fire? How can you show the water being thrown on the fire?</p> 	<h3>Maths</h3> <p>Making number bonds to 20 There are different ways to show number bonds to 20 (2 numbers that go together to make 20). Show different ways to learn your number bonds. You could even make a game!</p> 	<h3>Art</h3> <p>Draw a portrait of the King! What features do you need to draw? What does he look like? How can you improve your drawing?</p> 

Try to complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line, or any three that you like! Try to include the middle square if you can. Colour in each square as you complete that activity. To be completed no later than **Monday 16th March 2026** when we will celebrate and share all your projects.
