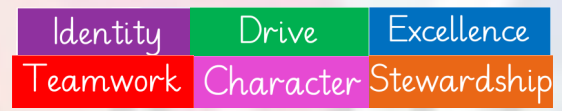




The Year 1 Spring curriculum map
