It has been lovely to welcome the children back to school after the Christmas break. Our new topic on space is called, 'Out of this World!'. We started with talking about what they know already and what they wanted to find out about. We then learnt about star constellations and used a map of the sky over Coventry to try and identify some constellations!

This week in Drawing Club, we read [Whatever Next!](#) by Jill Murphy. We thought about Baby Bear taking another trip to the moon and who he would take on his next trip. We had lots of different animals suggested.



In maths, we have been learning about 2D shapes and time. We have focused on the properties of squares and rectangles. We have enjoyed dancing to a days of the week video: [KSI English: Days of the Week - BBC Teach](#) and we talked about the differences in what we do during the day and night.

In phonics, we learnt that sometimes adding the plural 's' at the end of a word can make a 'z' sound, e.g. bugs, logs and bags. We have also learnt the 'qu' sound.
