



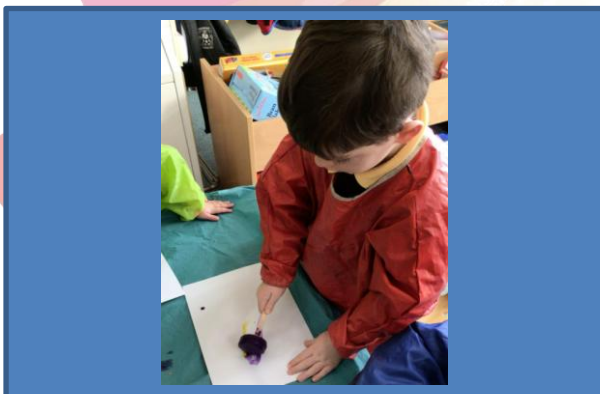
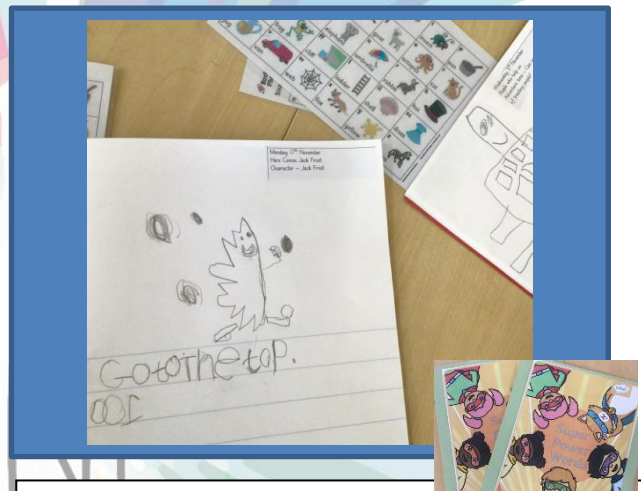
# In Reception this week...



Week beginning 17/11/25

This week we had lots of frozen inspired activities this week. We started with minibeasts and beads frozen in blocks of ice. We had fun warming up the ice with our hands to free the bugs! We've explored painting with frozen paint and we made some wonderful winter-inspired collage pictures using a variety of different materials.

This week in Drawing Club we looked at the story, '[Here Comes Jack Frost](#)'. We really enjoyed this winter-themed tale and it matched the recent cold weather! The children were asked to invent a machine to enable Jack Frost to stay and play with the boy even when the weather warms up. We had some super snow machines!



In phonics, we have added **r**, **h** and **b** to the sounds we know. Each child now has a 'Super Power Words' book. Please see the separate letter about these.
