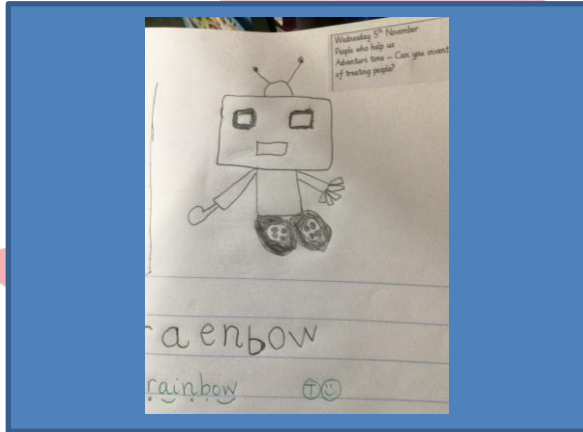




In Reception this week...

This week we have been thinking about people who help us. We enjoyed reading a non-fiction book about the jobs people do that help others. We also talked about the difference between fiction and non-fiction books. In drawing club our challenge was to invent something that would help doctors treat more people. The children drew some fantastic robots in response to this challenge!

In phonics, we have learnt **c** and **k**. We have practised writing these letters and writing short words with these sounds in.

We know lots of **tricky words** now - I, the, no, go, to and into. The children should start to recognise these in their reading books.



On Friday we welcomed one of our parents into school. We enjoyed hearing about what his job as a fire fighter involved and the special clothes he wears to protect him. Mrs Whateley looked very funny dressed as a fire fighter! We were all fantastic at the 'stop, drop and roll' technique.
