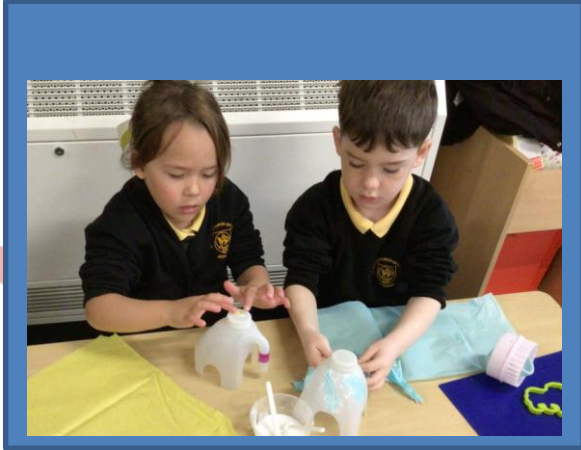




In Reception this week...



Week beginning 13/10/25

The Elmer fun carried on this week and the children made their own Elmers with milk bottles. They thought carefully about the colours they wanted to use and carefully tore the paper to make their patchwork design.

This week we have been looking at the book [Oliver's Vegetables](#). We worked in groups to put pictures from the story in the right order. We also wrote a shopping list for Mrs Whateley to go shopping for the items we needed to make vegetable kebabs. Reception were very careful when they put the vegetable pieces on their skewer and then we all sat together to try them. The children were great at trying the different vegetables and we thought of words to describe how they tasted.



We started phonics this week. The children have learnt the 'm' and 'p' sounds and we have practised writing them. Perhaps you could look out for these letters when you are out and about!
