We've enjoyed lots of Elmer activities this week. We enjoyed using lots of different colours to create some Elmer paintings. As part of our RHE work, we read the book 'I don't want to go sleep' and we talked about why it's important to get plenty of sleep!

In Drawing Club, we read '[Elmer](#)'. This has prompted lots of conversations about what makes Elmer special. We loved looking at all the different patterns at the end of the story and we designed some different elephant outfits for the Elmer parade.



We started phonics this week. The children have learnt the '[n](#)' and '[p](#)' sounds and we have practised writing them. Perhaps you could look out for these letters when you are out and about!
