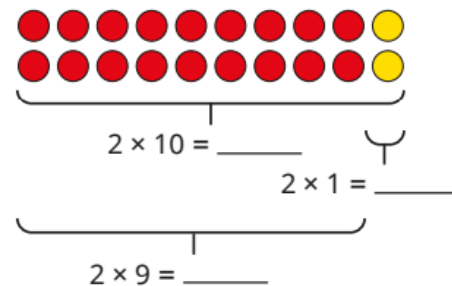

▶  $7 \times 10 = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$  and  $7 \times 1 = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$  so  $7 \times 9 = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$
