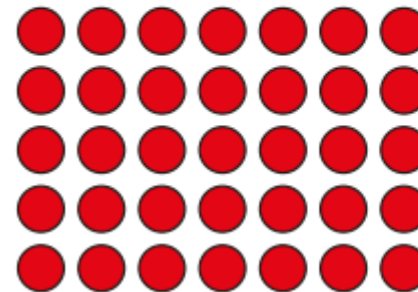
Here are three number tracks for the 3, 6 and 9 times-tables.
