



# In Reception this week...



Week beginning 9/3/26

It was British Science Week this week. We did an experiment with bubbles! The children started with the question, "Do bubbles always make a sphere shape?" We made different bubble wand shapes to see if we could make different shaped bubbles! We had lots of fun making bubbles in our outdoor area and watching to see the shapes they made.

This week we read [Handa's Surprise](#) by Eileen Browne. The children were asked to invent a way for Handa to transport the fruit safely to her friend. The children had some brilliant ideas including laser beams to protect the fruit from the animals! In topic we have located Kenya on a globe and on google earth. We have compared rural Kenya to where we live by using pictures of the areas.



We looked at some spring flowers we that noticed have been popping up around our school. We did some observational painting with watercolours which we have used to make something special!

In Phonics, we have recapped all the digraphs we have covered so far. This has been a great opportunity to practise using these digraphs in our writing. We have added six new words to the Super Power Word books. Please have a look at these with your child.

In maths, we have recapped 1 more and 1 less. We have put the number blocks in order from 1 to 10. We have also looked at which number blocks are less than 6 and which are more. We have talked about how a tower of cubes can either hide behind a tower of 6 or it will be taller.
