



In Reception this week...



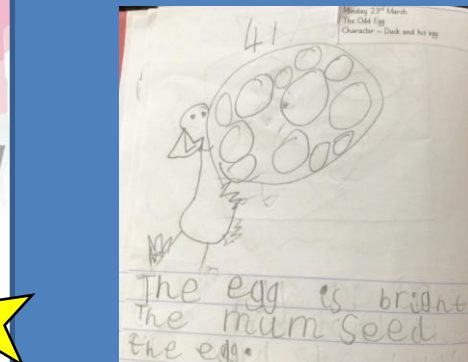

This week we read, '[The Odd Egg](#)' by Emily Gravett. Duck finds an enormous egg that he decides to look after. The children drew some fantastic pictures of duck and his egg. We had a lovely discussion about how Duck was taking care of his egg, despite the unkind comments from the other birds!



In Phonics, we learnt '[ow](#)' as in owl and '[ur](#)' as in fur. We put our phonics skills to good use with our Easter activities this week. Firstly, we read and followed instructions to make chocolate Easter nests. We also talked about how the chocolate changed from a solid to a liquid and then became a solid again! Secondly, we went on an Easter egg hunt around the classroom and outdoor area. Each egg had a picture and we had a go at writing the corresponding word.

In maths, we introduced the concept of doubling. We know this is when we have two lots of equal amounts. We practised this using our fingers. We also doubled the spots on Easter eggs.
