In topic, we had a visitors from the Lake View allotments. They helped us plant the potatoes that have been sprouting in our classroom. We are now on potato watch and watering duties!

We had a trip to the forest school area this week. We had maps that showed where different farm animals were hidden. We worked together to follow the maps and rescue all the farm animals!



In phonics we learnt the sound 'er' can make an 'uh' sound at the end of words, e.g. ladder, summer, hammer. We also spent time recapping some digraphs - ar, or, ur, ow.

In maths, we focused on accurate counting to 20 and beyond. We know the 'stopping number' is the total amount. We looked at larger sets of objects and talked about how to count these accurately as there are too many to subitise. We had a go at estimating how many objects we could see. We learnt we can either move objects or draw a line through them to keep track of which ones we had counted.
